


Accessibility

How do I use Axe Chrome to automatically test accessibility?

To start: go to download your [Web Accessibility Testing here](#)

1) Click on the button at the top right: Add to Chrome.



2) Click Add extension.




3) Your extension has been added.




4) Open the page you want to investigate for accessibility. In my example, I opened <https://www.bbc.com/>.




5) Place your mouse on the website and click the right mouse button. Then click on inspect.




6) Click on the tool Axe:




7) Select your role:



- 8) Click the checkbox: I agree and understand the Deque System Terms of Service and Privacy Policy "and then click the" Start Using Axe "button




- 9) Click on the button: "Scan all of my page".




10) Wait for the results to load


11) The results are displayed in a list that you can find in the inspector element:



12) Click the Highlight button to see where the error message can be found on the website.



13) You will find the result on the website in a pink bordered block.



14) Read and apply the suggested solution to resolve this accessibility issue in order to comply with the guidelines and check it after your customization.

15) Fix all errors found and your website will pass this accessibility checker with flying colours.
